Brigadier General Henry J. Nowak currently serves as the Director of U.S. European Command's Cyber and C4 Directorate (ECJ6). In this capacity, he is responsible for directing the employment and activities of assigned, attached, and supporting cyber forces to ensure the integrated planning, synchronization, monitoring, and assessment of joint cyber operations within USEUCOM's Area of Responsibility. Prior to this assignment, Brigadier General Nowak served as the Deputy Director for Trans-Regional Policy, Strategic Plans and Policy Directorate (J5), Joint Staff in Washington, D.C.



Upon graduating with a Bachelor's Degree in Political Science from Cleveland State University in 1979, Brigadier General Nowak was commissioned as an Infantry Officer in the U.S. Army through the Reserve Officers Training Program (ROTC). His infantry assignments included service with the 82nd Airborne Division at Fort Bragg, the United Nations Security Force-Joint Security Area in Korea, and the 3rd Infantry Division in Germany. As a Eurasian Foreign Area Officer, Brigadier General Nowak served as an arms-control inspector with the On-Site Inspection Agency-Europe (OSIA-E) and in successive military attaché assignments at U.S. Defense Attaché Offices in Moscow, Kiev, Kabul, and Warsaw.

Brigadier General Nowak holds a Master's Degree in International Relations from Yale University and in Strategic Studies from the U.S. Army War College. He is proficient in Russian, Ukrainian, and Polish.
