Brig. Gen. Mark L. Loeben is the Director of Analysis and Assessments and Senior Reserve Component Advisor to the Commander at Headquarters, United States European Command, Stuttgart-Vaihingen, Germany.

General Loeben entered the Air Force in 1986 as a Reserve Officer Training Corps graduate from George Washington University. He served as an instructor pilot in the T-37, C-141 and KC-10, as well as nuclear courier, Chief of Special Airlift Programs, Pentagon congressional liaison, and plans officer at Headquarters, U.S. Air Forces in Europe. General Loeben deployed as executive officer, Director of Mobility Forces, Combined Air and Space Operations Center, Southwest Asia. He has commanded an air refueling squadron, two air expeditionary groups, and served as Vice Commander of the U.S. Air Force Expeditionary Center.



In his previous assignment, General Loeben was Mobilization Assistant to the Director of Legislative Liaison on the Secretary of the Air Force staff. A command pilot, he has logged more than 4,700 flying hours in military aircraft and over 6000 hours as a civilian pilot. He is currently on a leave of absence from his position as an international pilot with a major U.S. airline to support his full-time military status.
